

## **ANNUAL REPORT 2023 -2024**

### **ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE**

We are proud of our student's academic accomplishments this year. We have secured 100% result for class X and XII. For class XII, 27 students Scored full A1. Jeswin Biju Koottala scored 100 marks for Computer and Neha T N for Economics. Jeswin Biju Koottala & Saniya Mary Jojo Scored 97.2% and was crowned as Science Toppers. Neha T N Scored 98% and became the commerce topper. For class X, 8 students scored full A1, 10 students, scored 100 marks for Social Science and Malayalam. Our schools' average score surpassed the national average in most subjects reflecting the commitment to academic excellence within our institution. We have received the MLA special award for achieving most number of A1 in class X and XII for the year 2023 in the Paravur educational region.

45 students from Chavara Darsan appeared in the International ABCUS Examination out of these 4 students were selected as super champions. They are Antonio Evan Ajay, Shreya J, Adwaith Sandeep and Lakshmi R Baliga. 20 students were adjudged champions.

## **EXTRA CURRICULAR SUCCESS**

Students have excelled outside the classroom as well. Many of our students excelled in Sahodaya Kalotsav and we were placed 5th position among 44 schools. We secured third position for the patriotic music in the state Shodaya kalotsav. We secured A grade for Vignesh V Vinoj and Elona Rose, Stion Shijo and Mary Rose Abey and B grade for Ann Merin Jaison

For the leaf Art competition conducted by Mathrubhumi Seed, we were placed in the First position. We bagged all the three prizes for the LP section and First prize in the UP section. We were awarded the crown Haritha Vidhyalaya in Aluva Education District by Mathrubhumi. We secured A+ grade for Nallapadam Activities organised by Malayala Manorama. Ms. Gouri Nandaof class vi D secured first position for the peace poster competition conducted by lions club. She received memento and cash prize of Rs. 15000/-.

Our sports team achieved commendable result in Inter school competitions. In Sahodaya Athletic Meet we secured first place in Super Senior category with 70 points and secured 5<sup>th</sup> place in total secure. Loriel Reese been the individual champion of super senior girl's category. We also secured First place in March past. Ayush Krishna V S of Class IV C has participated in marathon conducted by Fort Chochin Heritage and he could finish the same.

Our basketball team was placed runner up positions in Global Public School, Christav Mahilalaya and VISIO our inter school meet.
